6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to repeal of certain Federal
7 laws incorporated in the Alaska Code re-
8 lating to the executive department and
9 processes; repealing Sections 5-1-1 through
10 and including Sec. 5-1-5, Sec. 6-1-1
11 through and including Sec. 6-1-6, and
12 Sec. 38-8-3, ACLA 1949; and setting an
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

15 Section 1. DECLARATION OF INTENT. The Organic Act (37 Stat.
16 512; see 48 U.S.C. 24), as amended, as well as other Federal
17 laws relating to the Territorial executive departments and pro-
18 cesses have been incorporated into the Alaska Compiled Laws
19 Annotated 1949, and, by virtue of the Constitution of the State
20 of Alaska, such prior Territorial laws remain in effect until
21 repealed, thereby raising a conflict between the said Constitu-
22 tion and such prior incorporated laws; it is accordingly de-
23 clared to be the intent and purpose of this Act to repeal all por-
24 tions of the said Organic Act and certain other Federal statutes
25 as incorporated into the Laws of Alaska relating to the execu-
26 tive department and processes in order to remove such conflict.

27 Sec. 2. REPEALER. Section 5-1-1 through and including
28 Sec. 5-1-5, Sec. 6-1-1 through and including Sec. 6-1-6, and
29 Sec. 38-8-3, ACLA 1949 are hereby repealed.

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Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act will become effective immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
