6 For an Act entitled: "An Act pertaining to the regulation of  
7 hairdressing and beauty culture; amending  
8 Subsec. (11) of Sec. 1, Subsec. (1)(a),  
9 Subsec. (4) and Subsec. (5) of Sec. 4, and  
10 Sec. 10, all of Ch. 52, SLA 1957."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Subsec. (11) of Sec. 1, Ch. 52, SLA 1957, is  
13 hereby amended to read as follows:

14 (11) Student. A student is any person of the age  
15 of sixteen ~~SEVENTEEN~~ years or older who has completed two  
16 years of high school or who has equivalent education, who  
17 attends a duly licensed beauty school and who does not receive  
18 any wage or commission, and for whose work no charge is made  
19 until said student has had at least 350 hours of training.

20 Sec. 2. Subsec. (1)(a) of Sec. 4, Ch. 52, SLA 1957, is  
21 hereby amended to read as follows:

22 (a) He shall have attained the age of 17  
23 years.

24 Sec. 3. Subsec. (4) of Sec. 4, Ch. 52, SLA 1957, is hereby  
25 amended to read as follows:

26 (4) Admission without examination. A person who  
27 has been examined and issued a license by a board of cosme-  
28 tology in any state, territory, or the District of Columbia  
29 may be licensed in Alaska without examination and upon payment

1           of a fee of \$25.00.

2                   (a) Upon furnishing proof satisfactory to the  
3           Board that he holds such foreign license and that it is  
4           in effect upon the date of his application; and

5                   (b) Upon meeting such other requirements as  
6           may be established by the Board.

7           Shop owners may be licensed without examination, but  
8           unless otherwise qualified as an operator under this Act,  
9           shall not engage in the practice of hairdressing and/or  
10          beauty culture, but shall employ a licensed manager-operator.

11          Sec. 4. Subsec. (5) of Sec. 4, Ch. 52, SLA 1957, is hereby  
12          amended to read as follows:

13                   (5) License fees. The fees for various licenses

Sec. 10. HEARINGS: RULES AND REGULATIONS: ADMINISTRATIVE  
PROCEDURES ACT. Procedures under this Act shall be conducted  
pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 2 of the Administrative  
Procedures Act; rules and regulations adopted pursuant to  
this Act shall be adopted pursuant to the provisions of  
Chapter 1 of the Administrative Procedures Act.
