6 For an Act entitled: "An Act pertaining to the regulation of  
7 hairdressing and beauty culture; amending  
8 Subsec. (11) of Sec. 1, Subsec. (1)(a),  
9 Subsec. (4) and Subsec. (5) of Sec. 4,  
10 repealing and re-enacting Sec. 10, Ch. 52,  
11 SLA 1957."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. Subsec. (11) of Sec. 1, Ch. 52, SLA 1957, is  
14 hereby amended to read as follows:

15 (11) Student. A student is any person of the age  
16 of sixteen ~~SEVENTEEN~~ years or older who has completed two  
17 years of high school or who has equivalent education, who  
18 attends a duly licensed beauty school and who does not receive  
19 any wage or commission, and for whose work no charge is made  
20 until said student has had at least 350 hours of training.

21 Sec. 2. Subsec. (1) (a) of Sec. 4, Ch. 52, SLA 1957, is  
22 hereby amended to read as follows:

23 (a) He shall have attained the age of 17  
24 years.

25 Sec. 3. Subsec. (4) of Sec. 4, Ch. 52, SLA 1957, is hereby  
26 amended to read as follows:

27 (4) Admission without examination. A person who  
28 has been examined and issued a license by a board of cosme-  
29 tology in any state, territory, or the District of Columbia

1 may be licensed in Alaska without examination and upon payment  
2 of a fee of \$25.00.

3 (a) Upon furnishing proof satisfactory to the  
4 Board that he holds such foreign license and that it is  
5 in effect upon the date of his application; and

6 (b) Upon meeting such other requirements as  
7 may be established by the Board.

8 Shop owners may be licensed without examination, but  
9 unless otherwise qualified as an operator under this Act,  
10 shall not engage in the practice of hairdressing and/or  
11 beauty culture, but shall employ a licensed manager-operator.

12 Sec. 4. Subsec. (5) of Sec. 4, Ch. 52, SLA 1957, is hereby  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 (5) License fees. The fees for various licenses  
15 and renewals thereof under this Act shall be as follows:

16 Schools, registration and  
17 initial fee:

18 \$200.00 Renewal \$100.00

19 School owner, registration

20 and initial fee:

21 25.00 Renewal 15.00

22 Instructor-operator, registration

23 and initial fee:

24 25.00 Renewal 15.00

25 Owner-operator, registration

26 and initial fee:

27 15.00 Renewal 10.00

28 Owner only, beauty shop,

29 registration and initial fee:
