HOUSE BILL NO. 41

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to divorce; imposing a limitation upon date of trial and entry of decree; and conferring a duty upon the court to specify in the decree on the subject of remarriage."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. No divorce case shall be tried, nor any decree of divorce entered therein, until the complaint in such action shall have been on file for ninety days, and until ninety days shall have elapsed from the date of service of summons on the defendant: Provided, that in cases where summons by publication is had, the date of first publication of summons shall be equivalent to the date of service of summons in other cases for the purposes of this section.

Sec. 2. It shall be the duty of the court granting a divorce to specify in the order for judgement whether either or both of the parties shall be permitted to marry and, if so, when, and the court shall have jurisdiction to modify the decree of divorce at any time so as to permit one or both of the parties to marry as in his discretion he shall deem it right.
