6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska Motor Vehicle  
7 Act; amending the first paragraph of Sec. 5,  
8 Ch. 124, SLA 1951, as amended by Sec. 2 of  
9 Ch. 73, SLA 1953, as amended by Sec. 3 of  
10 Ch. 95, SLA 1957; and repealing Sec. 4 of  
11 Ch. 95, SLA 1957."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. The first paragraph of Sec. 5 of Ch. 124, SLA  
14 1951, as amended by Sec. 2 of Ch. 73, SLA 1953, as amended by Sec.  
15 3 of Ch. 95, SLA 1957, is hereby amended to read as follows:

16 Section 5. CERTIFICATES OF TITLE. No vehicle subject  
17 to registration under this Act, except foreign vehicles pro-  
18 vided for in section 3(3), shall be registered by the depart-  
19 ment unless the applicant for such registration at the same  
20 time makes application for and obtains an official certifi-  
21 cate of title of such vehicle, or shall present satisfactory  
22 evidence that such certificate of title has been previously  
23 issued to such applicant. The department shall not accept  
24 the application for the original registration or certificate  
25 of title of any vehicle in this State ~~TERRITORY~~, unless the  
26 vehicle at the time of the application is within the State  
27 ~~TERRITORY~~, except that the department may ~~SHALL~~ accept  
28 an application for any ~~TEMPORARY~~ registration and certifi-  
29 cate of title hereunder ~~AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 4 HEREOF~~ for

a motor vehicle which is not within the State TERMINATION  
when the application is made by a dealer holding a valid  
Alaska business license ACCOMPANIED BY AN AFFIDAVIT BY BOTH  
THE SELLER AND PURCHASER, GIVING THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF EACH  
A DESCRIPTION OF THE VEHICLE, AND A STATEMENT OF THE WEIGHT  
THEREOF WITH REFERENCE TO ANY VEHICLE SUBJECT TO FEES BASED  
UPON THE WEIGHT. With the exception of foreign vehicles  
provided for in section 3(3), it shall be unlawful for any  
person to drive or move, or for an owner knowingly to permit  
to be driven or moved, upon any highway, in the State TERRI-  
TORY any vehicle of the type required to be registered here-  
under for which a certificate of title has not been issued.

Sec. 2. Sec. 4 of Ch. 95, SLA 1957, is hereby repealed.
