HOUSE BILL NO. 56

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to provide for the disposition of the records and property of the former Alaska Statehood Committee; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The records and property of the former Alaska Statehood Committee shall be disposed of in the following manner:

(1) All records, minutes of meetings, and accounts shall be delivered into the possession and control of the secretary of state for inspection and cataloging prior to consignment to the state archives, records management division, or destruction, as shall be appropriate.

(2) All equipment, supplies, and research and reference materials shall be delivered into the possession and control of the Legislative Council which shall certify receipt of same to the secretary of state.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
