6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting the sale of intoxicating  
7 beverages on Sundays and on Christmas day;  
8 defining intoxicating beverages; making  
9 violation a crime; providing for the repeal  
10 of inconsistent acts; and setting an effective  
11 date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. No person, firm, corporation, organization or  
14 company shall manufacture, sell, buy, trade, barter, offer for  
15 sale or otherwise engage in commerce with or traffic in, intoxicating  
16 liquor between the hours of one o'clock A.M. and twelve  
17 o'clock P.M. of any Sunday or on Christmas day of any year. For  
18 the purpose of this Act, "intoxicating liquor" means any whiskey,  
19 brandy, rum, gin, wine, ale, porter, beer, and all other spiritous  
20 vinous, malt and other fermented or distilled liquors intended  
21 for human consumption and containing more than 1% alcohol by  
22 volume.

23 Sec. 2. The violation of this Act shall be a misdemeanor  
24 and any person convicted hereunder shall be punished by imprisonment  
25 in jail for a period of not less than seven days nor more  
26 than one year.

27 Sec. 3. All acts in conflict with the terms of this Act are  
28 hereby repealed.

29 Sec. 4. This Act shall become effective immediately upon its

1 passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
