BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. RESIDENCE REQUIRED OF OFFICIALS. No official of  
the State of Alaska shall serve in such capacity who is not a  
bona fide resident of the State. For the purpose of this Act,  
"official of the state" includes all heads of executive and  
administrative offices, agencies and departments of the state, all  
members of boards and commissions which act as the heads of such  
executive and administrative agencies, members of the legislature,  
and justices and judges of the state judiciary.

Sec. 2. SAME: FAMILIES OF OFFICIALS. The residence requir-  
ed of officials of the state includes the residence in Alaska of  
the immediate families of such officials. For the purpose of this  
Act, "immediate family" means spouse, and minor children only.

Sec. 3. FAMILIES IN RESIDENCE ELSEWHERE. Except in cases  
of removal for reasons of health, the removal by any official of  
the state of himself or his immediate family from residence in  
Alaska shall be deemed to be resignation by such official from  
his state office, and all his powers, duties, salary and emolu-  
ments arising from such office shall cease from the date of such  
removal.
