HOUSE BILL NO. 95

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act making provision for the survival of all causes of action upon the death of the claimant, or injured person; amending Sec. 61-7-2 ACLA 1949; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. All causes of action by one person against another, whether arising on contract or otherwise, survive to the personal representatives of the former and against the personal representatives of the latter. The executors or administrators of the claimant or injured person may maintain an action thereon against the party against whom the cause of action accrued, or, after his death, against his personal representatives.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
