6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making provision for the survival
7 of causes of action upon the death of the
8 claimant, or injured person; repealing Sec.
9 61-7-2 ACLA 1949; and providing for an
10 effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. All causes of action by one person against an-
13 other, whether arising on contract or otherwise, except those
14 involving defamation of character, survive to the personal rep-
15 resentatives of the former and against the personal representatives
16 of the latter. When the cause of action survives, as herein pro-
17 vided, the executors or administrators of the claimant or injured
18 person may maintain an action thereon against the party against
19 whom the cause of action accrued, or, after his death, against his
20 personal representatives.

21 Sec. 2. Section 2 of Chapter 7 of Title 61, ACLA 1949 is
22 hereby repealed and the provisions of Section 1 of this Act sub-
23 stituted therefor.

24 Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its
25 passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such
26 approval.
