6 For an Act entitled: "An Act permitting the state or any political
7 subdivision thereof to execute contracts with
8 labor organizations; repealing inconsistent
9 laws; and providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. UNION CONTRACTS PERMITTED. Notwithstanding the
12 provisions of any other law, the state or any political subdivision
13 thereof including, but without limiting the generality of the
14 foregoing, an organized borough, municipal corporation, independent
15 school district, incorporated school district, public utility dis-
16 trict and an association operating utilities under arrangement
17 with the Rural Electrification Administration, may enter into
18 union contracts with any labor organization whose members furnish
19 services to the state or such political subdivision. For the
20 purpose of this Act, "labor organization" includes any organization
21 which exists or may hereafter exist and which is constituted for
22 the purpose, in whole or in part, of collective bargaining or in
23 dealing with employers (including the state or political subdivi-
24 sion thereof) concerning grievances, terms or conditions of employ-
25 ment or of other mutual aid or protection in connection with em-
26 ployees.

27 Sec. 2. REPEAL. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with
28 the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed to the extent of
29 such conflict.
