6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating a Real Estate Examining
7 Board; setting forth the functions of said
8 Board; and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. There is hereby created a Real Estate Examining
11 Board consisting of two real estate brokers and one real estate
12 salesman, licensed under laws of the state. Members of the Board
13 shall be appointed by the governor and confirmed by the legis-
14 lature. Each member shall serve for a four year term. No person
15 shall be appointed a member of the Board who has not been for two
16 years a licensed real estate broker or salesman actively engaged
17 in such business in Alaska.

18 Sec. 2. The functions of examining and licensing of real
19 estate brokers, associate brokers and real estate salesmen, as
20 set out in Ch. 154, SLA 1957, shall be carried out by the Board
21 created by this Act.

22 Sec. 3. Members of the Board shall receive such payments,
23 per diem allowances and transportation expenses as are commensur-
24 ate with those allowed and paid members of other state examining
25 and licensing boards.

26 Sec. 4. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its
27 passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such
28 approval.
