5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act granting lands to the University of  
7 Alaska; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 Section 1. DEFINITIONS. For the purpose of this Act, the  
10 term defined shall have the following meaning:

11 (a) "Alaska Land Act" shall mean Chapter 184, SLA 1957,  
12 as amended.

13 (b) "Board" shall mean the Board of Regents of the  
14 University of Alaska.

15 (c) "Commissioner" shall mean the Commissioner of the  
16 Department of Natural Resources.

17 (d) "Director" shall mean the Director of the Division  
18 of Lands of the Department of Natural Resources.

19 (e) "Public Law 508" shall mean the Act of July 7, 1958  
20 (72 Stat 339) admitting the State of Alaska into the Union.

21 Sec. 2. DECLARATION OF INTENT. It is the intent of the  
22 Legislature to grant to the University of Alaska one million acres  
23 of land, to be selected, managed and disposed of under the pro-  
24 visions of the Alaska Land Act for the maximum benefit of the  
25 University. This grant of land shall be for the purpose of re-  
26 placing grants of certain Sections 33 in the Tanana Valley previ-  
27 ously allowed under federal law and now superseded by the provi-  
28 sions of Public Law 508.

29 Sec. 3. LAND GRANT SELECTION. In the selection by the  
CS for HB #176

1 State of Alaska of any lands granted under the provisions of sub-  
2 sections (a) and (b) of Sec. 6 of Public Law 508 the Commissioner,  
3 with the approval of the Board or its designate, shall identify  
4 that portion of such selection to be known as University Land.

5 Sec. 4. MANAGEMENT AND DISPOSAL OF LANDS. Subject to the  
6 provisions of the Alaska Land Act, the Board or its designate  
7 shall determine the policy by which lands acquired under this Act  
8 shall be managed or disposed of by the Director.

9 Sec. 5. REVENUES. The Director shall account for all monies  
10 received in the management or disposal of University Lands  
11 acquired under this Act, identify their source, and promptly  
12 transmit them to the proper fiscal department after crediting  
13 them to the proper fund as provided for by Sec. 5(10) of Article  
14 II of the Alaska Land Act.

15 Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall take effect immedi-  
16 ately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law  
17 without such approval.
