6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending the Alaska Aeronautics Act
7 relating to the operation and use privileges
8 of airport or air navigation facilities."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Paragraph 1, Subsection E, Section 5 of Chapter
11 123, SLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 1. Under State [TERRITORIAL] Operation: In operating
13 an airport or air navigation facility owned or controlled by
14 the State [TERRITORY], the Commission may enter into con-
15 tracts, leases and other arrangements covering periods not in
16 excess of fifty-five [TEN] years with any person or munici-
17 pality or the United States, granting the privilege of using
18 or improving such airport or air navigation facility or any
19 portion or facility thereof or space therein for commercial
20 or governmental purposes; conferring the privilege of supply-
21 ing goods, commodities, things, services or facilities at
22 such airport or air navigation facility. In each such case
23 the Commission may establish the terms and conditions and fix
24 the charges, rentals, or fees for the privileges or services,
25 which shall be reasonable and uniform for the same class of
26 privilege or service and shall be established with due regard
27 to the property and improvements used and the expense of
28 operation to the State [TERRITORY]; provided that in no case
29 shall the public be deprived of its rightful, equal and

uniform use of the airport, air navigation facility, or portion thereof.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
