6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the use of State-owned  
7 vehicles; providing for rules and regulations;  
8 providing exemptions; providing for penalties;  
9 and providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. USE OF STATE-OWNED VEHICLES. State-owned vehicles  
12 shall be used only in the conduct of state business. No state  
13 officer or employee shall use, or permit the use of, any state-  
14 owned vehicle other than in the conduct of state business.

15 Sec. 2. RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE USE OF STATE-  
16 OWNED VEHICLES. The Commissioner of Public Works shall prescribe  
17 the rules and regulations which:

18 (1) Define the use of state-owned vehicles which con-  
19 stitutes use in the conduct of state business and distinguish such  
20 use from misappropriation for private use.

21 (2) Prescribe use governing the storage of state-owned  
22 vehicles in those locations where storage space, under the juris-  
23 diction of the Department of Public Works, is available for stor-  
24 age of state-owned vehicles.

25 Sec. 3. EXEMPTIONS. The provisions of vehicles by this  
26 chapter shall not apply to the use of the Governor of the State.

27 Sec. 4. VIOLATION GROUNDS FOR DISMISSAL. Any violation by a  
28 state officer or employee of this chapter or rules and regulations  
29 adopted pursuant thereto, shall constitute grounds for dismissal

1 from state employment upon hearing as provided for other dismissals  
2 for cause.

3 Sec. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall take effect upon its  
4 passage and approval or upon becoming law without such approval.
