6 For an Act entitled: "An Act declaring the paramount power of
7 the State of Alaska over intrastate commerce
8 conducted within its borders; repealing in-
9 consistent laws; and providing for an
10 effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. DECLARATION OF STATE JURISDICTION OVER INTRA-
13 STATE COMMERCE. Pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 8 (d) of
14 Public Law 508, 85th Congress, whereby all of the territorial laws
15 in force in the Territory of Alaska at the time of the admission
16 of the state into the Union, including, in addition to laws
17 enacted by the Territorial Legislature of Alaska, all laws or
18 parts thereof enacted by the Congress of the United States, the
19 validity of which is dependent solely upon the authority of the
20 said Congress to provide for the government of Alaska prior to the
21 said admission of the state into the Union, continue in full force
22 and effect throughout the state except as modified or changed by
23 the said Public Law 508, or by the Constitution of the State of
24 Alaska, or as modified or changed by the Legislature of the State,
25 it is hereby declared that the State of Alaska assumes juris-
26 diction to the fullest extent permitted by the Constitution of the
27 United States over all intrastate commerce of whatever character
28 carried on wholly within the borders of the state.

29 Sec. 2. REPEALER. All laws or parts of laws in conflict

1 herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

2 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall take effect imme-
3 diately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law
4 without such approval.
