6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to change the premium payable by  
7 governmental units and their employees for  
8 group life and health insurance, amending  
9 subsection (c) of Section 2, Ch. 151, SLA  
10 1955; and providing for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Subsection (c) of Section 2, Ch. 151, SLA 1955,  
13 is hereby amended to read as follows:

14 (c) No eligible employee shall become insured unless  
15 he has given, to the governmental unit in which he is em-  
16 ployed, a written authorization to withhold from his salary  
17 or wage his share of the premium contribution. The state or  
18 other governmental unit which is the employer shall pay  
19 \$2.00 per month per employee who desires coverage on him-  
20 self only; and \$4.50 per month per employee who desires  
21 coverage on himself and dependents. Each employee who de-  
22 sires coverage shall pay the balance of the premium, in the  
23 form of payroll deductions. [THE PREMIUM CONTRIBUTION  
24 NECESSARY TO PAY FOR ONE-HALF THE COST OF SUCH EMPLOYEE'S  
25 INSURANCE. GOVERNMENTAL UNITS ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO PAY  
26 THE REMAINDER OF THE TOTAL PREMIUM ON EACH OF THEIR INSURED  
27 EMPLOYEES, NOT TO EXCEED \$2.00 PER MONTH FOR EACH EMPLOYEE  
28 DESIRING COVERAGE ON HIMSELF ONLY, AND NOT TO EXCEED \$4.50  
29 PER MONTH FOR EACH EMPLOYEE DESIRING COVERAGE OF SELF AND
