5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing the maximum annual
7 salaries of the heads of twelve principal
8 executive departments established by the
9 State Organization Act of 1959; stating the
10 authority for fixing the salary rates of
11 other state employees; authorizing the
12 limited continuation of certain salaries
13 now in effect; repealing Ch. 180, SLA 1957;
14 and providing for an effective date."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

16 Section 1. The head of each principal executive department
17 of the State of Alaska upon appointment and qualification as pro-
18 vided in the State Organization Act of 1959 shall receive an annual
19 salary as may be established by the governor. Such department
20 head shall not receive a salary in excess of the amount set oppo-
21 site the titles listed below:

22	Commissioner of Administration.	\$17,000.00
23	Attorney General.	17,000.00
24	Commissioner of Revenue	15,000.00
25	Commissioner of Education	17,000.00
26	Commissioner of Health and Welfare.	17,000.00
27	Commissioner of Labor	12,000.00
28	Commissioner of Commerce.	12,000.00
29	Adjutant General.	11,000.00

1	Commissioner of Natural Resources	\$17,000.00
2	Commissioner of Fish and Game	17,000.00
3	Commissioner of Public Safety	15,000.00
4	Commissioner of Public Works	17,000.00

5 Sec. 2. The salary rates of all other state employees of
6 the executive branch shall be as fixed by the head of each principal
7 department or as established by the salary plan of the Merit Sys-
8 tem Council for those departments coming under the jurisdiction
9 of the Merit System Council.

10 Sec. 3. Ch. 180, SLA 1957, is hereby repealed; provided,
11 however, that the salaries of the officers of the executive branch
12 listed therein shall continue in force until such time as the
13 successors to their functions and duties are appointed and quali-
14 fied pursuant to the provisions of the State Organization Act of
15 1959.

16 Sec. 4. This Act shall take effect upon its passage and
17 approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
