6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the Governor to
7 assign, apportion and postpone use of
8 funds, appropriated for carrying out the
9 functions of the government, among the
10 departments and agencies of state govern-
11 ment; and providing an effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. Sec. 21 of Ch. 64, SLA 1959 is hereby amended
14 to read as follows:

15 Sec. 21. TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS AND FUNDS. Any depart-
16 ment to which the functions, powers, and duties of a
17 previously existing department shall, for the purpose of
18 succession to all rights, powers, duties, obligations and
19 funds, as apportioned by the Governor, [AND OBLIGATIONS]
20 of the former department or agency, be deemed and held to
21 constitute a continuation of the former department or agency,
22 with the same force and effect as if the functions, powers,
23 and duties had not been assigned or transferred. All funds
24 heretofore appropriated to departments and agencies for
25 functions which are transferred by this Act from an existing
26 department or agency to a different department created or
27 continued by the terms of this Act shall be transferred and
28 apportioned with their function at the direction of the
29 Governor to the departments or agencies in which the functions

are vested. Whenever any such former agency is referred to by law, contract, or document, such reference shall be deemed to apply to the department in which the functions of such agency are vested by the terms of this Act.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
