7 apportion and postpone use of funds,
8 appropriated for carrying out the functions
9 of the government, among the departments and
10 agencies of state government; amending Sec.
11 21, Ch. 64, SLA 1959; and providing an

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 21 of Ch. 64, SLA 1959 is hereby amended to

Sec. 21. TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS. Any department to
which the functions, powers, and duties of a previously
existing department or other agency are by this Act assigned
and transferred shall, for the purpose of succession to all
rights, powers, duties, and obligations of the former depart-
ment or agency, be deemed and held to constitute a continuation
of the former department or agency, with the same force and
effect as if the functions, powers, and duties had not been
assigned or transferred. Whenever any such former agency is
referred to by law, contract, or document, such reference shall
be deemed to apply to the department in which the functions
of such agency are vested by the terms of this Act. All
funds appropriated to a department or agency affected by this
Act prior to the transfer or assignment of its powers, duties,

and functions under this Act, shall be transferred, and
apportioned at the direction of the Governor. The Governor
is hereby expressly authorized to make such line item trans-
fers of appropriations within and among the newly created or
continued departments or agencies as he deems proper to
effectuate the purposes of this Act.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage and
approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
