6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the per diem allowance  
7 of employees and officials of the state of  
8 Alaska when traveling on official business;  
9 amending Sec. 4, Ch. 60, SLA 1957; and pro-  
10 viding for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Sec. 4, Ch. 60, SLA 1957 is amended to read as  
13 follows:

14 Sec. 4. PER DIEM ALLOWANCE. Officials and employees of  
15 the state [TERRITORIAL] agencies, while traveling on official  
16 business and away from their designated posts of duty, shall  
17 be allowed, in lieu of their actual expenses for subsistence  
18 and all fees or tips, a per diem allowance to be prescribed  
19 by the commissioner of administration pursuant to the regula-  
20 tory authority set out in Sec. 9 of this Act, and in consulta-  
21 tion with the head of the agency concerned, not to exceed the  
22 rate of \$21.00 [\$15.00] for travel within or without the  
23 State [TERRITORY] of Alaska; provided however, that the maxi-  
24 mum per diem established by this section shall be paid only  
25 when the official or employee can produce receipts showing  
26 room rental costs of \$10.00 per day or more.

27 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1960.
