FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the per diem allowance of employees and officials of the state of Alaska when traveling on official business; amending Sec. 4, Ch. 60, SLA 1957; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 4, Ch. 60, SLA 1957 is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 4. PER DIEM ALLOWANCE. Officials and employees of the state [TERRITORIAL] agencies, while traveling on official business and away from their designated posts of duty, shall be allowed, in lieu of their actual expenses for subsistence and all fees or tips, a per diem allowance to be prescribed by the commissioner of administration pursuant to the regulatory authority set out in Sec. 9 of this Act, and in consultation with the head of the agency concerned, not to exceed the rate of \$18.00 [\$15.00] for travel within or without the State [TERRITORY] of Alaska.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1960.
