6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to municipal taxation of  
7 intoxicating liquors; amending Sec. 35-4-18,  
8 ACLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 131, SLA 1957  
9 and Ch. 197, SLA 1959; and providing for  
10 an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Sec. 35-4-18, ACLA 1949 as amended by Ch. 131,  
13 SLA 1957 and Ch. 197, SLA 1959 is hereby amended to read as  
14 follows:

15 Sec. 35-4-18. MUNICIPAL REGULATIONS. Incorporated  
16 municipalities may, by ordinance duly enacted, provide such  
17 rules and regulations governing the barter, sale and  
18 possession of intoxicating liquor within such municipalities  
19 as may be deemed necessary to the orderly conduct of the  
20 business of selling intoxicating liquor; provided, however,  
21 that such ordinance or ordinances shall not be inconsistent  
22 with this Act or the rules and regulations promulgated  
23 hereunder, nor shall any municipality impose additional  
24 taxes other than property taxes on liquor inventories and  
25 sales taxes on liquor sales when such taxes are levied  
26 on other property and sales within the municipality.

27 Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its  
28 passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such  
29 approval.
