HOUSE BILL NO. 263

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to municipal taxation of intoxicating liquors; amending Sec. 35-4-18, ACLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 131, SLA 1957 and Ch. 197, SLA 1959."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 35-4-18, ACLA 1949 as amended by Ch. 131, SLA 1957 and Ch. 197, SLA 1959 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 35-4-18. MUNICIPAL REGULATIONS. Incorporated municipalities may, by ordinance duly enacted, provide such rules and regulations governing the barter, sale and possession of intoxicating liquor within such municipalities as may be deemed necessary to the orderly conduct of the business of selling intoxicating liquor; provided, however, that such ordinance or ordinances shall not be inconsistent with this Act or the rules and regulations promulgated hereunder, nor shall any municipality impose additional taxes other than property taxes on liquor inventories and sales taxes on liquor sales when such taxes are levied on other property and sales within the municipality.
