5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to appropriate the sum of  
7 \$242,625 to cover the operating expenses  
8 of the legislature; and providing for an  
9 effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated  
12 the sum of \$242,625, or as much thereof as may be needed, out of  
13 the general fund of the state for the operating expenses of the  
14 1960 regular session of the legislature, to be apportioned  
15 according to the following schedules:

16 (1) For the per diem of members of the legislature  
17 for 60 days pursuant to Sec. 1, Ch. 1, SLA 1959;  
18 ..... \$ 144,000

19 (2) For the per diem compensation of the President  
20 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House the additional sum  
21 of \$1,600 for actual days spent in the capital for official and  
22 necessary post-session work; ..... \$ 1,600

23 (3) For the compensation of temporary legislative  
24 employees according to the positions and rates established by  
25 Ch. 6, SLA 1959;..... \$ 57,200

26 (4) To the Legislative Council for the fulltime com-  
27 pensation of duplicating service employees for the equivalent  
28 of three calendar months, for contractual services; ..... \$ 5,250

29 (5) For the travel allowances of members of the

1 legislature pursuant to provisions of Ch. 36, SLA 1959;  
2 ..... \$ 9,575

8 (6) For the printing, binding and indexing of the  
4 session laws of 1960 and for other printing; ..... \$ 20,000

5 (7) For the other operating expenses of the session:  
6 Supplies ..... \$ 2,000  
7 Equipment ..... 2,500  
8 Telephone and Telegraph 500 \$ 5,000

9 Sec. 2. METHOD OF EXPENDITURE. The monies appropriated  
10 hereby shall be expended by the engrossment and enrollment  
11 committees of each house, acting jointly through the legislative  
12 fiscal officer.

13 Sec. 3. UNENCUMBERED BALANCES. With the exception of the  
14 amount appropriated in paragraph (4), Sec. 1 of this Act and such  
15 amounts as may be allocated by the joint engrossment and enroll-  
16 ment committee for clerical help for necessary post-session work,  
17 all unencumbered and unused balances herein shall revert to the  
18 general fund.

19 Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall take effect  
20 immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming  
21 law without such approval.
