6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to alcoholic beverages;  
7 amending subsec. (D), Sec. 35-4-21, ACLA  
8 1949 as amended by Ch. 131, SLA 1957 and Ch.  
9 197, SLA 1959."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Subsec. (d), Sec. 35-4-21, ACLA 1949 as amended  
12 by Ch. 131, SLA 1957 and Ch. 197, SLA 1959 is amended to read as  
13 follows:

14 (D) A Club License shall give to clubs, fraternal  
15 organizations, and patriotic organizations, that have a State  
16 or National Charter, and which have been so incorporated and  
17 active for a period of two years or more, the right to sell  
18 intoxicating liquors to their members and their families only  
19 in their club rooms. The Club License Fee shall be Four  
20 Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars, except that for any club which  
21 has gross sales of intoxicating liquor for the preceding year  
22 of less than Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars the Club  
23 License Fee shall be One Hundred and Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars.
