HOUSE BILL NO. 276

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to alcoholic beverages; amending subsec. (D), Sec. 35-4-21, ACLA 1949 as amended by Ch. 131, SLA 1957 and Ch. 197, SLA 1959."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Subsec. (d), Sec. 35-4-21, ACLA 1949 as amended by Ch. 131, SLA 1957 and Ch. 197, SLA 1959 is amended to read as follows:

(D) A Club License shall give to clubs, fraternal organizations, and patriotic organizations, that have a State or National Charter, and which have been so incorporated and active for a period of two years or more, the right to sell intoxicating liquors to their members and their families only in their club rooms. The Club License Fee shall be Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars, except that where any club has certified to the board that the gross sales of intoxicating liquor for the preceding year were less than Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars, the Club License Fee shall be Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars.
