9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Sec. 2, Art. II, Ch. 94, SLA 1959 is amended to
 11 read as follows:

12 Sec. 2. LICENSE AND TAG FEES.

13	(1) Resident sport fishing license	\$ 5.00
14	(2) Resident hunting license	7.00
15	(3) Resident [HUNTING AND] trapping	
16	license	<u>3.00</u> [10.00]
17	(4) Resident hunting and trapping	
18	license	<u>10.00</u>
19	(5) [(4)] Resident hunting <u>and</u> [&] sport	
20	fishing license	12.00
21	(6) [(5)] Resident hunting, trapping	
22	<u>and</u> [&] sport fishing license	15.00

23 Provided, however, that the above license may be
 24 obtained by the head of any family or one solely dependent
 25 upon himself for support for a fee of \$.25 upon proof pre-
 26 sented by the applicant that the applicant (1) is obtaining
 27 or has obtained during the immediately preceding six months,
 28 assistance under any state or federal welfare program to aid
 29 the indigent, or (2) has an annual income of less than \$800.00

1 for the year immediately preceding application, or (3) has
2 historically been dependent on fish and game for subsistence.

3 (7) [(6)] Visitor's special sport fish-
4 ing license - valid only for ten (10) days after
5 date of issuance \$ 5.00

6 (8) [(7)] Non-resident and alien sport
7 fishing license 10.00

8 (9) [(8)] Non-resident and alien hunt-
9 ing license 50.00

10 (10) [(9)] Non-resident and alien hunt-
11 ing and sport fishing license 60.00

12 Providing that non-residents or aliens may not take
13 big game animals without previously purchasing appropriate
14 tags as provided for hereinafter, and which must be affixed
15 to the animal immediately upon taking and remain affixed
16 until the animal is prepared for storage, consumed or ex-
17 ported.

18 (11) [(10)] Non-resident and alien hunt-
19 ing and trapping license 100.00

20 (12) [(11)] Registered guide license .. 50.00

21 (13) [(12)] Assistant guide license ... 25.00

22 Provided that no guide or assistant guide licenses
23 may be issued by the Commissioner until rules and regulations
24 governing guide qualifications and examinations, and the
25 general conduct of guiding activities in the State are formu-
26 lated.

27 (14) [(13)] Resident fur dealer and [&
28 taxidermy license \$ 20.00

29 (15) [(14)] Non-resident and alien

12 Provided that the Commissioner may issue to any
13 person without cost permits to collect fish and game, sub-
14 ject to such limitations and provisions as he deems approp-
15 riate, for scientific or educational purposes.
