HOUSE BILL NO. 303

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the acceptance of bribes by a member of the legislature; prescribing penalties; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Any member of the legislature who shall accept or receive any money, or the loan of any money, or any real or personal property, or any pecuniary or other personal advantage, present or prospective, directly or indirectly, or any promise, check, order, contract, retainer, employment or promise of future employment, undertaking, obligation, or security for the payment of money or for the delivery or conveyance of anything of value to him or to any person, partnership or corporation, with his consent, connivance, or concurrence, as a consideration or inducement for supporting or opposing any measure or person for any official position, or giving or withholding any vote upon, or doing or omitting to do any act in reference to any question or matter pending in either house of the legislature, or as a reward for having supported or opposed any measure or given or withheld any vote, or having done or omitted to do any act in reference to any such measure, question or matter so pending, or purloining any papers in the hands of the officers of either house of the legislature - and the provisions of this Act shall apply to votes given or cast by any member of the legislature voting at any

1 caucus or meeting of the members of the legislature held to
2 nominate or designate any person for whom the members of the legis-
3 lature shall vote, either in joint session of the legislature, or
4 in either house thereof - shall be subject to the penalties pro-
5 vided for in this Act.

6 Sec. 2. Any legislator violating provisions of this Act shall
7 be punished by a fine of not less than \$200.00 nor more than
8 \$1,000.00, or by imprisonment for not less than one year nor more
9 than seven years in jail, or by both such fine and imprisonment,
10 at the discretion of the court; and shall forfeit his office and
11 be disqualified from holding any office of honor or trust in the
12 State of Alaska.

13 Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
14 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
