3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating current federal
7 transitional grants from the general fund;
8 and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. The legislature recognizes
11 that the federal transitional grants made available to the State
12 of Alaska during the current period have been paid into the gen-
13 eral fund of the state, and that it is necessary to specifically
14 appropriate them to the functions and purposes intended by the
15 federal government. During the interim between the first and
16 second sessions of the First State Legislature the governor made
17 the necessary appropriations as authorized by Ch. 177, SLA 1959.
18 This gubernatorial authority expired upon the convening of the
19 second session, and it is the intent of this appropriation bill
20 to make the needed appropriations of current transitional grants.

21 Sec. 2. The sum of \$7,812,500 is appropriated out of the
22 federal transitional grants in the general fund of the state
23 according to the following schedules:

25 To the grant-in-aid fund for
26 disease and sanitation
27 investigation and control
28 for the fiscal year ended
29 June 30, 1960

1 To the grant-in-aid fund for
2 Alaska Mental Health for
3 the fiscal year ended
4 June 30, 1960 \$ 200,000

5 DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES

6 To the Division of lands for
7 the maintenance and con-
8 struction of roadside
9 campgrounds for the year
10 ended June 30, 1960 \$ 25,000

11 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

12 To the Division of Aviation
13 for capital improvements
14 at the Fairbanks and
15 Anchorage International
16 Airports \$3,455,000

17 To the Division of Highways
18 as follows:
19 Highway maintenance and
20 matching funds for
21 participation in the
22 Federal Highway Aid
23 Program \$2,176,127

24 Revolving fund: (1) for
25 preliminary unallocated
26 right-of-way acquisition
27 and engineering expenses;
28 and (2) to cover necessary
29 expenses of the Federal

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Highway Aid Program
prior to reimbursement
from the federal government

\$1,798,373

Total, Division of Highways \$3,974,500

Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its
passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such
approval.
