HOUSE BILL NO. 305

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating current federal transitional grants from the general fund; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. The legislature recognizes that the federal transitional grants made available to the State of Alaska during the current period have been paid into the general fund of the state, and that it is necessary to specifically appropriate them to the functions and purposes intended by the federal government. During the interim between the first and second sessions of the First State Legislature the governor made the necessary appropriations as authorized by Ch. 177, SLA 1959. This gubernatorial authority expired upon the convening of the second session, and it is the intent of this appropriation bill to make the needed appropriations of current transitional grants.

Sec. 2. The sum of \$7,812,500 is appropriated out of the federal transitional grants in the general fund of the state according to the following schedules:
