10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Section 33-3-131 ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 16,
12 SLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 122, SLA 1951, is hereby amended
13 to read as follows:

14 Sec. 33-3-131. BOUNTY ON HAIR SEAL DECLARED. There is hereby
15 placed on every hair seal inhabiting the inland waters and all wat-
16 er adjacent to the southern coast of Alaska east of the 152nd Mer-
17 idian, and the waters of Bristol Bay and the coastal waters within
18 three miles off the Mainland ~~FROM STEBBINS TO CAPE KRUZENSTERN/~~
19 from Cape Newenham to Cape Kruzenstern, inclusive, a bounty of
20 \$3.00, suchsum to be paid in accordanance with the provisions fol-
21 owing.

22 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall become retroactive to
23 January 1, 1960, upon its passage and approval or upon its becom-
24 ing law without such approval.
