HOUSE BILL NO. 315

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act exempting resident persons sixty years of age and over from purchase of sport hunting and fishing licenses; amending Sec. 9, Art. II, Ch. 94, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 9, Art. II, Ch. 94, SLA 1959 is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 9. EXEMPTIONS. No license shall be required of any resident or non-resident person under the age of sixteen for the purpose of sport fishing, nor shall a license be required of any resident under the age of sixteen for hunting or trapping, nor shall licenses be required of any resident sixty years of age or older for sport hunting and sport fishing.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect January 1, 1961.
