5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to authorize the use of certain
7 legislative duplicating equipment for gov-
8 ernmental purposes and providing for an
9 effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Ch. 5, SLA 1959 is amended to read as follows:

12 Sec. 1. AUTHORIZATION. The legislative fiscal officer
13 is hereby authorized in accordance with proper fiscal pro-
14 cedure, to purchase and install the following equipment:

15 Two (2) Xerox Copying Units including the acces-
16 sories thereto in an amount not to exceed \$10,750.00;

17 Two (2) Multilith Offset Duplicators, including
18 the accessories thereto in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00;

19 Two (2) Thomas Collators, including the accessories
20 thereto in an amount not to exceed \$2,357.00.

21 Provided, however, the equipment herein described shall
22 be placed under the control of the Alaska Legislative Coun-
23 cil during the periods when not in use by the Legislature.

24 The legislative duplicating equipment shall be used primari-
25 ly for the duplicating needs of the legislature and its
26 agencies but may, upon request of the governor, or the head
27 of a principal department of the executive, and subject to
28 the legislative priority, be used to implement the mimeo-
29 graph and other duplicating equipment now being used by

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
