HOUSE BILL NO. 330

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska Motor Vehicle Act; providing special exceptions; amending Sec. 3, Ch. 124, SLA 1951, as amended by Ch. 50, and Ch. 73, SLA 1953, Ch. 120, SLA 1957, and Ch. 73, SLA 1959."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 3, Ch. 124, SLA 1951 as amended by Ch. 50 and Ch. 73, SLA 1953, Ch. 120, SLA 1957, and Ch. 73, SLA 1959 is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 3. REGISTRATION OF VEHICLES. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or move, or for an owner knowingly to permit to be driven or moved, upon any highway any motor vehicle, trailer, or semi-trailer which has not been registered under this act; provided that when any vehicle subject to registration is to be moved upon the public highways of this state from one point to another, the Department of Revenue may issue a special permit therefor upon an application being presented in such form as shall be approved and upon payment therefor of a fee of \$5.00. Such permit shall be for the transit of the vehicle only, and the vehicle shall not at the time of such transit be used for the transportation of any persons or property whatsoever for compensation or otherwise, and shall be for one transit only between the points of origin and the destination as set forth in the

application; except that, when such vehicle is to be moved
from one point in this state to another and when the owner
of such vehicle desires to carry a load of passengers or
commodities, or both, he may obtain a one transit permit
upon payment of a fee of \$10.00.
