FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to exemptions from over-
time hours provisions of the Alaska Wage
and Hour Act; repealing Subsec. (1), Sec. 3,
Ch. 171, SLA 1959; adding a new subsection
to Sec. 3, Ch. 171, SLA 1959; and providing
for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Subsec. (1), Sec. 3, Ch. 171, SLA 1959 is
repealed.

Sec. 2. Sec. 3, Ch. 171, SLA 1959 is amended by adding a
new subsection to read as follows:

(7) Any employee of an employer engaged in the operation
of a hospital or the operation of a hotel or restaurant busi-
ness insofar as an employee is not employed in excess of 48
hours in any continuous seven day period.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
