6 For an Act entitled: "An Act transferring the tourism and econo-
7 mic development functions of the Department
8 of Natural Resources to the Department of
9 Commerce; amending Ch. 122, SLA 1959; and
10 providing for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. The first paragraph of Sec. 2, Ch. 122, SLA 1959
13 is amended to read as follows:

14 Sec. 2. The Department of Commerce [NATURAL RESOURCES]
15 is hereby authorized, in addition to its functions as other-
16 wise provided by law, to perform the following powers and
17 duties:

18 Sec. 2. Sec. 6, Ch. 122, SLA 1959 is amended to read as
19 follows:

20 Sec. 6. The Commissioner of Commerce [NATURAL RESOURCES]
21 is hereby authorized with the approval of the Governor to
22 establish within the Department of Commerce [NATURAL RE-
23 SOURCES] such divisions or other administrative or organiza-
24 tional units as he may determine necessary to carry out the
25 functions of this Act.

26 Sec. 3. Sec. 7, Ch. 122, SLA 1959 is amended to read as
27 follows:

28 Sec. 7. REPEAL AND TRANSFER OF PROPERTY. Ch. 180, SLA
29 1955, as amended by Ch. 152, SLA 1957, and Ch. 107, SLA 1951,

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as amended by Ch. 127, SLA 1953, as amended by Ch. 82, and Ch. 168, SLA 1955, as amended by Ch. 91, SLA 1957, are hereby repealed. All records, equipment, and other property of the Resource Development Board, as it existed under the provisions of law repealed herein, are hereby transferred to the Department of Commerce [NATURAL RESOURCES].

Sec. 4. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1960.
