6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing that all persons are  
7 entitled to the free and equal enjoyment  
8 of accommodations, amusements, and con-  
9 veyances; amending Sec. 20-1-3, ACLA 1949;  
10 providing penalties; and setting an  
11 effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. Sec. 20-1-3, ACLA 1949, is amended to read as  
14 follows:

15 Sec. 20-1-3. All persons within the jurisdiction of  
16 the  ~~Territory~~ State of Alaska shall be entitled to the  
17 full and equal enjoyment of accommodations, ~~resorts, amuse-~~  
18 ~~ments,~~ advantages, facilities and privileges of public inns,  
19 restaurants, eating houses, hotels, soda fountains, soft  
20 drink parlors, taverns, roadhouses, barber shops, beauty  
21 parlors, bathrooms, resthouses, theaters, skating rinks,  
22 cafes, ice cream parlors, transportation companies, and all  
23 other conveyances ~~and~~, amusements, and accommodations,  
24 subject only to the conditions and limitations established  
25 by law and applicable alike to all ~~citizens~~ persons;  
26 and any denial of the use of such conveyances, amusements,  
27 or accommodations by reason of race, creed, or color of the  
28 applicant therefore shall be a violation of this section.  
29 A place of accommodation, resort, or amusement within the

1           meaning of this section shall mean any establishment which  
2           caters or offers its services or facilities or goods to the  
3           general public, including but not limited to, public  
4           housing, all forms of publicly assisted housing, and any  
5           housing accommodation offered for sale, rent or lease that  
6           is one of two or more housing accommodations all of which  
7           are located on a single parcel of land or parcels of land  
8           that are contiguous without regard to roads or streets, and  
9           all of which any person owns or otherwise controls the sale,  
10           rental or lease thereof. Any person who shall violate any  
11           provision of this section shall be fined not more than  
12           \$100.00 or imprisoned not more than 30 days or both.

13           Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
14           and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
