HOUSE BILL NO. 346

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act for the relief of Don Skuse and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The Governor of Alaska is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and present a treasury warrant drawn against any monies in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, in favor of Don Skuse of Juneau, Alaska, in the amount of \$80.35, and the Commissioner of Administration is hereby authorized and directed to pay said amount to said person upon presentation in the regular manner of said warrant to him. The payment of such sum shall be in full settlement of all claims of such person against the State of Alaska, any agency thereof, and any persons, for any expenses incurred in connection with the burial of Rose Rona of Juneau.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
