6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the furnishing of return  
7 transportation by employers upon termination  
8 of employment; amending Sec. 1, Ch. 67, SLA  
9 1949 as amended by Ch. 136, SLA 1959; and  
10 providing for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Sec. 1, Ch. 67, SLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 136,  
13 SLA 1959, is amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1. Any employer who furnishes, finances, or  
15 agrees to furnish or finance, or who in any way provides  
16 transportation for any person from the place of hire to any  
17 point within or without the State of Alaska for the purpose  
18 of employing him shall, on or after the termination of employ-  
19 ment for any good and sufficient cause in the opinion of the  
20 Commissioner of Labor, beyond the control of such person, or  
21 on or after the termination of the contract of employment, or  
22 any renewal thereof, provide such person upon his request, or  
23 the request of the Commissioner of Labor, made within 45 [10]  
24 days after the termination of employment, with return trans-  
25 portation to the place of hire from which transportation was  
26 furnished or financed, or to destination agreed upon by the  
27 parties with transportation to be furnished or financed, pro-  
28 vided that upon such termination of employment the subsistence  
29 of the employee shall not continue longer than ten days after

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termination of such employment or until such time as trans-  
portation is available [UNTIL AT LEAST SUCH TIME AS TRANS-  
PORTATION IS COMMENCED].

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
