6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to prohibit milk which has been
7 frozen or in which dehydrated or powdered
8 milk has been mixed from being labeled or
9 offered for sale as fresh milk."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Milk which has been frozen or in which dehydrated
12 or powdered milk has been mixed may be labeled or offered for sale
13 as fresh frozen milk or freshly reconstituted milk or with some
14 similar restrictive adjective which will inform the purchaser that
15 it has been frozen or that dehydrated or powdered milk has been
16 mixed into it, but it may not be labeled as fresh milk.

17 Sec. 2. Any person convicted for violating the provisions of
18 this Act shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$200.00 or
19 by imprisonment for a period not exceeding 90 days or by both.
