FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to public hearings of the  
Local Boundary Commission; amending Sec. 3,  
Ch. 185, SLA 1959."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 3, Ch. 185, SLA 1959 is amended to read as  
follows:

Sec. 3. MEETINGS: HEARINGS: QUORUM. a. The commission  
shall meet at such times and such places as may be necessary  
to carry out the purpose of this Act. A majority of the full  
membership of the commission shall constitute a quorum to  
transact business; provided, that it shall take an affirma-  
tive vote of the majority of the membership to carry all  
decisions or proposals.

b. Before the commission may propose any local boundary  
establishment or change, it must conduct at least one public  
hearing at a centrally located place within the limits of  
the area to be affected by the local boundary establishment  
or change. Public notice of the hearing shall be made at  
least 15 days before the date of the hearing and shall include  
the time, date, place, and subject of the hearing.
