HOUSE BILL NO. 354

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to commercial fishing licenses; amending Sec. 6, Art. III, Ch. 94, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 6, Art. III, Ch. 94, SLA 1959 is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 6. COMMERCIAL FISHING LICENSES. A commercial fishing license shall be obtained by each and every individual before he shall become engaged as a fisherman as above defined. The fee for such license shall be \$10.00 for residents, and \$15.00 for non-residents. Application for commercial fishing licenses shall be made between January 1 and April 15 of each year to the commissioner or his duly authorized deputies in the registration area in which the applicant will fish, and shall be made in person by the person to be licensed. The application shall be accompanied by the required fee and containing such reasonable information as may be required by the commissioner. Such applications shall be simple in form and shall be executed by applicants under the penalties of perjury.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect on January 1, 1961.
