HOUSE BILL NO. 367

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act making certain use of a telephone a misdemeanor."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Any person who uses obscene or profane language when speaking to another on the telephone, or who persistently call another on the telephone for the purpose of annoying or disturbing that person or his family, or who threatens another with bodily harm when speaking on the telephone is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment for a period not more than 30 days.

Sec. 2. After the ninetieth day following the effective date of this Act, every telephone directory published for distribution to the general public shall contain the provisions of Section 1 of this Act; the provisions shall be printed in type which is no smaller than any other type on the same page and to be preceded by the word "WARNING" in capitals and bold-face; provided that the provisions of this section do not apply to those directories distributed solely for business advertising purposes, commonly known as classified directories.
