FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to non-resident and alien big game tags; and amending subsec. (16), Sec. 2, Art. II, Ch. 96, SLA 1959."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Subsec. (16), Sec. 2, Art. II, Ch. 96, SLA 1959, is amended to read as follows:

(16) Non-resident and alien big game tags:

Brown or grizzly bear	<u>75.00</u>	[25.00]
Polar bear		150.00
Black bear, deer		10.00
Bison, moose, sheep		50.00
Walrus		100.00
Elk, goats, caribou..Each.....		25.00

Provided that the Commissioner may issue to any person without cost permits to collect fish and game, subject to such limitations and provisions as he deems appropriate, for scientific or educational purposes; and provided further, that tags not used for specific animals may be utilized to satisfy the tagging requirements for any species of equal or less evaluation.
