5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to caribou and feral rein-  
7 deer."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 Section 1. TAKING CARIBOU OR FERAL REINDEER PROHIBITED. No  
10 person may take, pursue, capture, or kill caribou or feral (wild)  
11 reindeer within the area described as follows: Beginning at a  
12 point along the Arctic Ocean six miles Southeast of Kivalina,  
13 Alaska, at approximately Latitude  $67^{\circ}41'$  N., Longitude  $164^{\circ}21'$  W.;  
14 thence Northeasterly to Latitude  $67^{\circ}45'$  N., Longitude  $163^{\circ}00'$  W.;  
15 thence Southeasterly to Latitude  $66^{\circ}52'30''$  N., Longitude  $158^{\circ}00'$   
16 W.; thence South to Latitude  $66^{\circ}00'$  N., Longitude  $158^{\circ}00'$  W.;  
17 thence West to Latitude  $66^{\circ}00'$  N., Longitude  $159^{\circ}34'$  W.; thence  
18 South to Latitude  $65^{\circ}20'$  N., Longitude  $159^{\circ}34'$  W.; thence West to  
19 Latitude  $65^{\circ}20'$  N., Longitude  $160^{\circ}26'$  W.; thence South to Latitude  
20  $64^{\circ}48'$  N., Longitude  $160^{\circ}26'$  W.; thence East to Latitude  $64^{\circ}48'$   
21 N., Longitude  $159^{\circ}34'$  W.; thence South along Longitude  $159^{\circ}34'$  W.,  
22 to the right or Northwesterly bank of the Yukon River; thence  
23 following the right bank of the Yukon River downstream in a South-  
24 westerly direction to the Village of Anvik, Alaska, at approxi-  
25 mately Latitude  $62^{\circ}38'$  N., Longitude  $160^{\circ}15'$  W.; thence West to  
26 the 164th Meridian; thence North along 164th Meridian to a point  
27 on the mean high tide line on the South side of Norton Sound;  
28 thence along the mean high tide line of the ocean back to the  
29 point of beginning.
