6 For an Act entitled: "An Act empowering and directing the Director  
7 of the Division of Lands of the Department  
8 of Natural Resources to convey certain real  
9 property to Parents Association for Retarded  
10 Children of Alaska for a limited use; and  
11 providing for an effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. The Director of the Division of Lands of the  
14 Department of Natural Resources upon concurrence of the governor,  
15 is empowered and directed to convey by quitclaim deed, subject to  
16 the reservations provided for in Sec. 1, Art. VII, Ch. 169, SLA  
17 1959, any and all interest of the State of Alaska, in the North-  
18 west quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 21, Township 13  
19 North, Range 3 West, Seward Meridian, State of Alaska, containing  
20 40 acres more or less to the Parents Association for Retarded  
21 Children of Alaska or its successors in interest, so long as said  
22 real property and appurtenances thereto are used in a nonprofit,  
23 nonsectarian manner for the care, teaching, training, rehabilita-  
24 tion, and housing of retarded children and related functions. The  
25 Director shall make such restricted conveyance within a reasonable  
26 time after said land has been conveyed to the State of Alaska by  
27 the United States of America.

28 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
29 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
