6 For an Act entitled: "An Act empowering and directing the Director
7 of the Division of Lands of the Department
8 of Natural Resources to lease certain real
9 property to Parents Association for Retarded
10 Children of Alaska for a limited use; and
11 providing for an effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. The Director of the Division of Lands of the
14 Department of Natural Resources upon concurrence of the governor,
15 is empowered and directed to offer by noncompetitive lease the
16 Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 21, Township
17 13 North, Range 3 West, Seward Meridian, State of Alaska, contain-
18 ing 40 acres more or less to the Parents Association for Retarded
19 Children of Alaska or its successors in interest, so long as said
20 real property and appurtenances thereto are used in a nonprofit,
21 nonsectarian manner for the care, teaching, training, rehabilita-
22 tion, and housing of retarded children and related functions. The
23 Director shall make such restricted conveyance within a reasonable
24 time after said land has been conveyed to the State of Alaska by
25 the United States of America.

26 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
27 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
