HOUSE BILL NO. 438

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to lands subject to homestead entry; amending Sec. 6, Art. III, Ch. 169, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 6, Art. III, Ch. 169, SLA 1959 is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 6. HOMESTEAD ENTRY. The Director, with the approval of the Commissioner, may authorize homestead entry on lands not under grazing lease or otherwise appropriated [AND WHICH ARE CLASSIFIED AS AGRICULTURAL LANDS AND GRAZING LANDS], if they are not school lands, mental health lands or lands conveyed to Alaska by the Federal Government for the specific purpose of producing revenue.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
