4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to barbers, barbering, and  
7 barber schools and colleges in Alaska;  
8 amending Ch. 68, SLA 1957; and providing for  
9 an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 1, Art. II, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is amended to  
12 read as follows:

13 Section 1. BOARD: MEMBERSHIP. There is hereby created  
14 the Board of Barber Examiners to be composed of Five (5)  
15 members appointed by the Governor. The members of the [FIRST]  
16 Board shall come from a list of recommendations furnished by  
17 the legislative committees of the prevailing barber organiza-  
18 tions in the State of Alaska. The appointments from this  
19 list shall give each judicial district representation on the  
20 Board. The fifth member shall be appointed from the district  
21 having the largest number of practicing licensed barbers.

22 [MADE BY PRACTICING BARBERS IN ALASKA, AND THEREAFTER FROM A  
23 LIST OF RECOMMENDATIONS BY LICENSED BARBERS IN ALASKA.] They  
24 shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor.

25 Sec. 2. Subsec. (f), Sec. 3, Art. II, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is  
26 amended to read as follows:

27 (f) To delegate any of its powers of examining,  
28 [AND] inspection, and enforcement to a member or members of  
29 the Board. [COMMITTEE OF ITS MEMBERSHIP; PROVIDED, THAT NO

1 SUCH COMMITTEE SHALL BE COMPOSED OF LESS THAN THREE MEMBERS;]  
2 It shall be the duty of the member or members to carry out  
3 all such assignments by the Board in the judicial district  
4 in which the Board member resides.

5 Sec. 3. Sec. 3, Art. III, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is amended to  
6 read as follows:

7 Section 3. EXAMINATION FEES [FEE]. Any person making  
8 application for examination must submit with his application  
9 an examination fee as follows:

10 Examination for barber license. . . . . \$25.00  
11 Examination for barber teacher license. . . \$75.00

12 [OF TWENTY-FIVE (\$25.00) DOLLARS. IF THE APPLICANT SUCCESS-  
13 FULLY PASSES SAID EXAMINATION, THE EXAMINATION FEE SHALL BE  
14 ACCEPTED AS FULL PAYMENT OF THE LICENSE FEE FOR THE FIRST  
15 YEAR OF PRACTICE.]

16 Sec. 4. Art. III, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is amended by adding a  
17 new section 3A to read as follows:

18 Section 3A. LICENSE FEES. The fees for various licenses  
19 and renewals thereof under this Act shall be as follows:

20 Barber license. . . . .  
21 . . . . .initial fee \$10.00...renewal \$10.00  
22 Barber teacher license. . . . .  
23 . . . . .initial fee \$50.00...renewal \$50.00  
24 Barber school or college license. . . . .  
25 . . . . .initial fee \$150.00..renewal \$150.00

26 Sec. 5. Sec. 4, Art. III, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is amended to  
27 read as follows:

28 Section 4. LICENSE. Licenses shall be issued by the  
29 Board to any applicant who passes the examination [,] for

1 said license, and who possesses the other qualifications  
2 required by law. (1) All licenses and temporary permits  
3 shall have a photograph of the licensee or permittee attached.  
4 (2) Every licensee or permittee shall display his license or  
5 permit in a conspicuous place in his place of business. Shop  
6 owners, barber school or college operators or managers shall  
7 be responsible for the display of all licenses held by  
8 employees in their shops, schools or colleges. (3) A dupli-  
9 cate license or permit may be issued to a licensee or  
10 permittee upon proof that his original license has been lost  
11 or destroyed upon payment of \$1.00.

12 Sec. 6. Sec. 5, Art. III, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is amended to read  
13 as follows:

14 Sec. 5. RENEWAL. Licenses issued by the Board shall be  
15 valid for a term of one year subject to annual renewal by  
16 issuance of a new license. If renewal fees are not paid  
17 before July 1 of each year, a penalty of \$2.00 shall be added  
18 to the renewal fee. Any license not renewed by September 1  
19 of each year shall lapse. A person who has allowed his  
20 license to lapse may have his lapsed license re-instated,  
21 provided that such license has not been lapsed for a period  
22 of more than five years and that he pays a sum which is  
23 twice the amount of the renewal fee. [A FEE OF TEN (\$10.00)  
24 DOLLARS SHALL ACCOMPANY EACH APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL.]

25 Sec. 7. Sec. 1, Art. IV, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is amended to  
26 read as follows:

27 Sec. 1. FAILURE TO POSSESS LICENSE. Any person who  
28 engages in, or attempts to engage in, the practice of barber-  
29 ing or operates a barbers' school or college or teaches



1 cations as a barber teacher; (4) such other information as  
2 may be required by regulations duly adopted by the Board.

3 Section 4. EXAMINATION. Every applicant for a barber  
4 teacher license must demonstrate to the Board that he has  
5 the ability to instruct barber students in all subjects  
6 necessary to qualify them as competent barbers by passing  
7 an examination in theory and practice.

8 Section 5. SCHOOL LICENSE. No barber school or college  
9 may operate without a license issued by the Board. Said  
10 license shall be issued when the Board determines that the  
11 school or college is properly staffed with licensed barbers  
12 and the premises and equipment are sufficient, sanitary,  
13 and proper.

14 Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
15 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
